

1. Nobody has asked me to support the increase of GMO in European agriculture and food. Moreover I have to emphasise that as Member of AGRI Committee of European Parliament I have received a hundreds e-mails from persons and organisations, who don't want GMOs and who asked me to reject the Motion for a European Parliament Resolution on biotechnology: Prospects and Challenges for Agriculture in Europe (2006/2005 (ini)).
2. For me it is obvious that public opinion based decisions should be taken on GMO and I do my best as one of the decision makers in EU to take these decisions in regard of their opinions. Safety of citizens - in this case - the environmental safety, which implicates health safety is the most important issue nowadays.
3. There are a lot of opinions about GMOs and there isn't conviction about the effects on other crops, the environment and human/animal health. Moreover there are many proofs about the dangers of GMOs - for example allergies, increasing plant resistance for pesticides, contamination.
4. No, I do not support coexistence. It is practically impossible. Distances between fields are too short and the possibility to cross between these two kinds of crops is very high.
5. There is no evidence that genetically modified organisms will not cross contaminate other crops/plants in, and beyond, the area in which they are planted. We discuss about nature and it isn't possible to protect non GMO crops from GMO ones. It is probably possible, but only under controlled conditions in laboratory.
6. Regulations should be undertaken. Farmers who don't want to cultivate GMOs - in case of the contamination of their own crops - should receive compensation from those farmers who contaminated their crops with GMOs.
7. Yes. I will reject the Motion for a European Parliament Resolution on biotechnology: Prospects and Challenges for Agriculture in Europe (2006/2005 (ini)). I strongly criticised this controversial draft resolution on AGRI Committee meeting on 21st of November 2006.
8. Yes, I will. I signed previous Moratorium on GMO.
9. I took personal responsibility and that's why I am trying to stop the introduction of GMOs into the environment.
